1 **Information:**

2 In an on going investigation into the drug trafficking by David Meddaugh, undersigned officer drafted a search warrant for  
 3 his residence at [REDACTED] which was signed by Magistrate Paterson of the 43<sup>rd</sup> District Court.

4 **Investigation:**

5 On 02-21-02 at approximately 1745hrs. undersigned officer along with other NET officers and officers Geuricki and Wilke  
 6 (Ferndale uniformed officers) and officer Strick (Hazel Park PD K-9 handler) went to the target address to execute the search warrant.  
 7 Upon arrival officer Buchholz knocked on the back door (NW door) of the residence and announced in a loud clear voice, "Police,  
 8 Search Warrant". Officers waited and did not get a response at the door. Officer Buchholz again knocked on the door and announced  
 9 in a loud clear voice, "Police, Search Warrant". Officers did not get a response at the door. Officer Buchholz opened the unlocked  
 10 door and officers made entry, securing the occupants. Officers found S-1-David Meddaugh in the kitchen area of the house and S-2  
 11 William Battistel in the basement near his bedroom.

12 Officers advised the residents that we had a search warrant for the residence, for drugs. At this time [REDACTED] stated,  
 13 "let me save you some time, my weed is in that black cabinet in my bedroom" pointing to the south bedroom. (Converted from living  
 14 room to bedroom) Undersigned officer went and the south bedroom and located the listed 25.5 gram bag of Marijuana inside a black  
 15 cabinet, which was against the north bedroom wall. Undersigned officer also located several proofs of residency for [REDACTED]  
 16 within the south bedroom.

17 Officer Woodmore found the list 150 gram bag of Marijuana inside a small cabinet just outside S-2 Battistel's bedroom door.  
 18 The cabinet was affixed to the wall just to the west of Battistels bedroom door opening. Officer Woodmore also found the listed 30.2  
 19 gram bag of Marijuana inside a nightstand drawer, which was next to Battistel's bed in his bedroom. Sgt. Miles found the listed 32.9  
 20 gram bag of Marijuana on top of a stereo speaker inside Battistel's bedroom. (Speaker closest to door) Sgt. Miles found the listed 4.5  
 21 gram bag of Marijuana inside Battistel's coat pocket, along with his Michigan identification card. Battistel's coat was inside his  
 22 bedroom. Sgt. Miles also found the two listed mechanical scales inside battistel's bedroom. One was on top of a tall dresser and the  
 23 second was on an entertainment center near the TV. Sgt. Miles also found the listed box of clear plastic baggies inside Battistel's  
 24 dresser and proofs of residency throughout the bedroom addressed to [REDACTED]

25 Officer Brown found the listed 0.7 grams of Marijuana on a tabletop in the workroom in the basement. Officer Brown also  
 26 found the listed box of plastic baggies and triple beam scale in the workroom next to the Marijuana.

27 **Interview of S-1 [REDACTED]**

28 Officer Brown advised [REDACTED] of his Miranda rights and asked him if he would speak with officers regarding the  
 29 investigation. [REDACTED] informed officer Brown that he understood his rights and wished to waive them and speak with officers.  
 30 When questioned [REDACTED] admitted to selling Marijuana to friends. [REDACTED] stated that the Marijuana found in the south  
 31 bedroom is his, for his own personal use. [REDACTED] also stated that the Marijuana (0.7 grams), baggies and scale found in the  
 32 workroom are his.

1 Interview of S-2 William Battistel:

2 Undersigned officer advised Battistel of his Miranda rights and asked him if he wanted to talk to officers regarding the  
3 investigation. Battistel informed officer that he understood his Miranda rights and would answer questions. When questioned  
4 Battistel stated that the Marijuana found in cabinet next to his room and all of the Marijuana found in his room is his. Battistel also  
5 admitted that the scales and packaging material found in his room are his. Battistel stated that he does not sell Marijuana and all of the  
6 Marijuana was for his own personal use.

7 Arrest:

8 Officer placed both [redacted] and Battistel under arrest for possession with intent to deliver Marijuana. Officers Guericki  
9 and Wilke transported them to the Ferndale police department for processing.

10 Evidence/Field Test:

11 Officer field tested a sample of the Marijuana found in [redacted]'s bedroom and a sample of the Marijuana found in  
12 Battistel's bedroom using a Duquenois Reagent tester and received a positive indication for Marijuana on both individual tests.

13 Officer tagged all the evidence and placed it into a NET evidence locker.
