PETITION FOR RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE

Petitioner, [REDACTED], through her attorney, AIDA SPAHIC, moves this Honorable Court to order Respondent to issue a restricted license and in support states:

1. Petitioner resides at [REDACTED], in [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] County, Michigan.
2. On [REDACTED], Petitioner was stopped and arrested by the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for Operating While Intoxicated.
3. That the Petitioner refused to submit to the chemical test as required by MCL 257.625a(6).

4. That pursuant to MCL 257.625f Petitioner's license was suspended for one year from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]
5. That the suspension will work great hardship on the Petitioner.
 - a. Petitioner is a single mother of a two year old son.
 - b. Petitioner is a full time student at [REDACTED], in the city of [REDACTED] attending classes 35 hours per week. She attends classes Tuesday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
 - c. Petitioner is currently employed by the [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] Michigan. She is a part time server, working 15-20 hours per week. She typically works Friday through Sunday from 6 p.m. to 12 a.m.
 - d. Petitioner is in grave need of a driver's license in order to maintain employment, attend school, and take care of her child. She is unable to rely on any family members or friends for transportation.
 - e. In order to get to school from home, Petitioner takes Southfield Freeway or Greenfield Rd., depending on the traffic. She then takes Interstate 696 to Woodward. After school, Petitioner returns home to change clothes prior to going to work.
 - f. In order to get to work from home, Petitioner takes Interstate 96 to Middlebelt Rd. or 5 Mile to Middlebelt Rd., depending on the traffic.
 - g. There is insufficient public transportation in Petitioner's area to allow Petitioner to use public transportation for her needs.
6. The current arrest is the first arrest for Petitioner for a drinking and driving offense and she has no prior implied consent suspensions.

7. That Petitioner is eligible to petition the Circuit Court in the county in which she was arrested to request the Court to order the Secretary of State to issue Petitioner a restricted license pursuant to MCL 257.323c to run concurrently with any license action taken by the Secretary of State in conjunction with this arrest.

WHEREFORE IT IS PRAYED this Honorable Court order the Secretary of State to issue Petitioner a restricted license during her implied consent suspension to allow Petitioner to drive to and from work, to drive in the course of employment, to drive to and from school, and to drive to any court ordered activity.
