1 ON THE ABOVE LISTED TIME AND DATE WRITER WAS ON ROUTINE PATROL NORTHBOUND ON LAHSER
2 APPROACHING TEN MILE. AS WRITER APPROACHED THE INTERSECTION ON TEN MILE/ LAHSER WRITER
3 OBSERVED A 1994 BLACK PONTIAC BONNEVILLE FACING WESTBOUND ON TEN MILE AT LAHSER WITH THE
4 DRIVERS DOOR OPEN, THE DRIVER HAD HIS HEAD OUT OF THE DOOR.

5 WRITER TURNED ONTO TEN MILE FROM LAHSER AND PULLED BEHIND THE ABOVE LISTED VEHICLE. THE
6 LIGHT TURNED GREEN FOR WEST BOUND TRAFFIC; THE ABOVE LISTED VEHICLE PROCEEDED THROUGH THE
7 INTERSECTION CONTINUING ON TEN MILE. WRITER FOLLOWED BEHIND THE ABOVE LISTED VEHICLE PACING IT
8 AT 70 MPH IN A 40MPH ZONE WEST BOUND ON TEN MILE, SWERVING IN THE LANE.

9 WRITER ACTIVATED THE OVERHEAD LIGHTS AND AFFECTED A TRAFFIC STOP ON TEN MILE AT BERG RD.
10 WRITER APPROACHED THE VEHICLE AND SPOKE TO THE SOLE DRIVER IDENTIFIED AS KENNETH EDWARDS.
11 WRITER ASKED EDWARDS FOR HIS DRIVERS LICENSE AND VEHICLE INFORMATION. WRITER COULD SMELL AN
12 ODOR OF ALCOHOL EMITTING FROM THE INTERIOR OF THE VEHICLE AND EDWARDS. WRITER ASKED EDWARDS
13 WERE HE WAS COMING FROM, EDWARDS REPLIED

16 WRITER ASKED EDWARDS TO STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND ASKED HIM TO SUBMIT TO FIELD
17 SOBRIETY TEST. EDWARDS AGREED TO THE TEST. WRITER ASKED HIM WHAT HIS EDUCATION CONSISTED OF;
18 EDWARDS STATED THAT HE HAS A BACHELORS DEGREE FROM LAWRENCE TECH UNIVERSITY. WRITER ASKED
19 EDWARDS TO SAY THE ALPHABET FROM A-S, EDWARDS STATED THE ALPHABET A-T WHILE SINGING IT. THE
20 NEXT TEST CONSISTED OF THE FINGER TO NOSE TEST. WRITER DEMONSTRATED THE TEST AND ASKED
21 EDWARDS TO DO IT. EDWARDS HAD TROUBLE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS BY DOING THE TEST WHILE I WAS
22 DEMONSTRATING IT. EDWARDS WAS THEN ASKED TO DO THE HEEL TO TOE TEST ON EVEN PAVEMENT 8 STEPS
23 FORWARD AND 6 STEPS BACK. AGAIN EDWARDS HAD TROUBLE FOLLING DIRECTIONS. EDWARDS STARTED
24 THE HEEL TO TOE TEST WITH HESITATION TRYING TO GET HIS BALANCE. WHILE TAKING THE 8 STEPS
25 FORWARD EDWARDS HAD TO CATCH HIMSELF FROM FALLING BY STEPING OF THE LINE IN THE PAVEMENT.
26 SEE PSYCHO NARRATIVE REPORT.

27 WRITER THEN ASKED EDWARDS TO SUBMIT TO A PBT TEST. WRITER READ OFF THE PBT RIGHTS,
28 EDWARDS AGREED TO TAKE THE PBT TEST WITH A RESULT OF .145. WRITER ARRESTED EDWARDS FOR OWI,
29 HANDCUFFED (TC/ DL) AND PATTED DOWN. ON EDWARDS REQUEST HIS VEHICLE WAS PARKED AT 23800 W. TEN
30 MILE RD WITH THE VEHICLE LOCKED. EDWARDS WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO THE SOUTHFIELD JAIL FOR
31 PROCESSING. OFC FREEMAN READ EDWARDS HIS CHEMICAL BREATH TEST RIGHTS WHICH HE AGREED TO
32 TAKE. OFC FREEMAN ADMINISTERED THE CHEMICAL BREATH TEST ON THE DATA MASTER WITH A RESULT OF
33 .15 BOTH TIMES. LT FITZGERALD REVIEWED THE ARREST AND SET A BOND OF \$300.00.

- * Causing serious injury to another while operating a vehicle while under the influence of, or while visibly impaired by an alcoholic liquor or a controlled substance or a combination of both, or with an unlawful bodily alcohol content.
- * Operating a commercial motor vehicle with a bodily alcohol content of 0.04 grams or more but less than 0.08 grams per 100 milliliters of blood, per 210 liters of breath, or per 67 milliliters of urine.
- * Operating a vehicle while less than 21 years of age and having any bodily alcohol content.
- * Murder resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle.
- * Manslaughter resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle.
- * Felonious Driving.
- * Negligent Homicide.
- * Refusing a Preliminary Breath Test if arrested while operating a commercial motor vehicle.
- * Endangerment (Operating while intoxicated with person under age of 16.)

CHEMICAL TEST RIGHTS

I am requesting that you take a chemical test to check for alcohol and/or controlled substances in your body. IF YOU WERE ASKED TO TAKE A PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST BEFORE YOUR ARREST, YOU MUST STILL TAKE THE TEST I AM OFFERING YOU.

If you refuse to take this chemical test, it will not be given without a court order, but I may seek to obtain such a court order. Your refusal to take this test shall result in the suspension of your operator's or chauffeur's license and vehicle group designation or operating privilege, and the addition of six points to your driving record.

After taking my chemical test, you have a right to demand that a person of your own choosing administer a breath, blood, or urine test. You will be given a reasonable opportunity for such a test. You are responsible for obtaining a chemical analysis of a test sample taken by a person of your own choosing.

The results of both chemical tests shall be admissible in a judicial proceeding, and will be considered with other admissible evidence in determining your innocence or guilt.

*MCL 257.625c(2) provides that a person afflicted with hemophilia, diabetes, or a condition requiring the use of an anticoagulant shall not be considered to have given consent to the withdrawal of blood.
